TP Goat Grower contains a complete mineral and vitamin package to increase growth, reproductive performance and to provide an additional boost to the goats immune system. This feed is also medicated to prevent coccidiosis and contains ammonium chloride to help reduce the development and occurrence of urinary calculi in goats. This feed is specifically designed for goats and should not be fed to sheep due to elevated copper levels.

**FEED DIRECTIONS**

Feed to goats at a rate of 2.5 to 5 lb daily to provide not less than 25 mg and no more than 50 mg of Lasalocid per head per day.

**IMPORTANT MANAGEMENT PRACTICES**

Provide a source of clean water and free choice minerals at all times. When making changes in an animal's diet, plan a 7-10 day transition period. Always provide ample feeder space for livestock. Do not feed wet, moldy, or insect infested feed.
