### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This supplement is intended for cattle only. Do not feed to sheep. This is a supplement, not a complete ration, and must be fed with adequate roughage and grain.

This supplement may be fed top-dressed, mixed into other components of the ration, or provided in a free-choice lick wheel feeder.

When fed for the first time, or after feeders have been empty, be sure cattle have other feeds available and feed the supplement so that intake is no more than 1.5 lb/hd/day for the first week.

This supplement includes minerals and vitamins, but a free-choice mineral/vitamin supplement is recommended to compensate for variations in ration composition and animal needs.

Daily intake should range from 1 to 3 lb/hd/day for a 1000 lb animal. If intake is outside this range, check the following:

- Tank Location - Intake is higher when tanks are located near water, mineral feeders, shelter, or other areas frequented by cattle.
- Calves - calves can and should consume the liquid. Their intake must be allowed for also.
- Supplemental feedstuffs - If cattle are over-consuming, the other feedstuffs may be short of phosphorus or energy. Be sure the mineral includes adequate phosphorus and that the total ration is adequate in energy.
