Required Qualifications

Must be 18 years or older and at least a sophomore enrolled in a university/community college.

Knowledge, Skills & Abilities

- Must be self-motivated and have a willingness to learn.
- Must have time management and punctuality.
- Ability to communicate with customers and associates.
- Must have a valid drivers license.

Work Environment
